Miller Moths: Understanding and Managing the Migration

If you're a Colorado native, you're probably familiar with the annual migration of miller moths (also known as army cutworms) from the eastern plains to the mountains. This migration typically occurs between May and June, lasting anywhere from 4 to 6 weeks, with the peak migration happening over a span of two weeks. The severity of the migration varies each year, influenced by factors such as moisture, temperature, and the cultivation of early crops, which impacts caterpillar and pupae development.

How Miller Moths get inside

Miller moths are notorious for seeking out small cracks and crevices around your home, especially in areas such as:

- Doors
- Windows
- Soffits
- Siding
- Rock beds

It's through these tiny openings that moths accidentally make their way inside.

Managing Miller Moths Inside

While it's tempting to use insecticides, they are not effective at controlling miller moths indoors and are generally a waste of time. The most effective solutions are:

- **Vacuuming:** Simply vacuum up moths around windows or other areas where they congregate. This is the quickest and most efficient way to handle moths indoors.
- **Light Traps:** These traps attract and capture moths. If you're interested, we offer light traps for rent. Give us a call for more information.

Exclusion involves sealing up any cracks and crevices around your home to prevent moths from entering. While this method can help, it is often very difficult to find and seal every tiny opening, making it nearly impossible to completely block them out.

Stinging Insects: Spring Season Awareness & Preventive Measures

As spring arrives, you may begin to notice an increase in the presence of stinging insects like wasps, bees, and hornets. Understanding the differences between these insects is important, as they each have distinct roles in our ecosystem. Here's a guide on how to handle these insects safely and effectively, particularly honeybees, which are vital pollinators.

Honeybees: Beneficial Pollinators

During spring, it's common to witness swarms of honeybees. This is a natural occurrence where the hive splits, and the bees are in search of a new home. These swarms are usually found in clusters on fence posts or in trees. The best course of action is to leave them undisturbed. In 99% of cases, the honeybees will move on overnight. If the bees establish a hive in a wall void or another location that poses a risk, contact us immediately. We can help coordinate with a local beekeeper to safely and humanely relocate the bees.

Wasps and Hornets: Early Spring Activity

Wasps and hornets can be more noticeable during early spring. The only wasps and hornets that survive the winter are the founding queens. On warm days, these queens are often seen around soffits, gutters, fences, and other sheltered areas as they start building their nests. They typically construct their first few cells, which they use to lay eggs that will later hatch into worker insects.



This is the ideal time to prevent future issues by addressing and removing any early-stage nests. Our **Stinging Insect Service** can help remove these nests before they grow larger and more aggressive.
